2023 Tootsie Roll Drive Knights Bulletin

Save the Dates! **April 28 th and 29th** the Knights of Columbus annual community Tootsie Roll Drive will be held. The key to success centers on People Power! The Lord provides eve rything needed to aid those with intellectual disabilities served by Cardinal Services, Special Olympics, and Magical Meadows except for your YES to volunteer and help.

In 2022, 67 volunteers shared their time and talent to work 323 man hours on Tootsie Roll weekend. 37 of those volunteers were from Knights of Columbus and Sacred



Heart Parish members. 10,800 Tootsie rolls were distributed and \$19,728 was raised.

The Knights Tootsie Roll project has been going strong for 47 years. Warsaw's Tootsie Roll records go back to 1986; since that time the Warsaw council has raised \$580,855. We need your help to keep this tradition going.

The Lord will again place the cars and shoppers on the streets and at the stores on April 28 th and 29th. 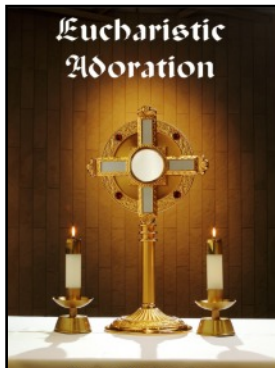

Pro Life News

PRO-LIFE As we look out upon the injustices against those who stand up for LIFE, it would be easy for us to get discouraged. The same type of arbitrary actions by our government agencies are being done by agencies in other countries and in particularly in the U.K. These misguided laws have the same purpose and that is to silence all those who champion LIFE.

On Feb. 16 two British Catholics were acquitted of all charges related to praying outside an abortion facility in the city of Birmingham. One of those was a catholic priest. They were charged under the 2014 law, Anti -Social Behavior, Crime Act 2014 which creates Public Spaces Protection Orders. The priest, Fr. Cough stood near the abortion facility holding a sign, "Praying for Free Speech". The charge: Intimidating service users." He was also charged for a sticker on his car which read, "Unborn lives matter". Alliance Defending Freedom represented Fr. Cough. This case was in the court system for two and one half months before an acquittal was granted due to "lack of evidence." (National Catholic Register)

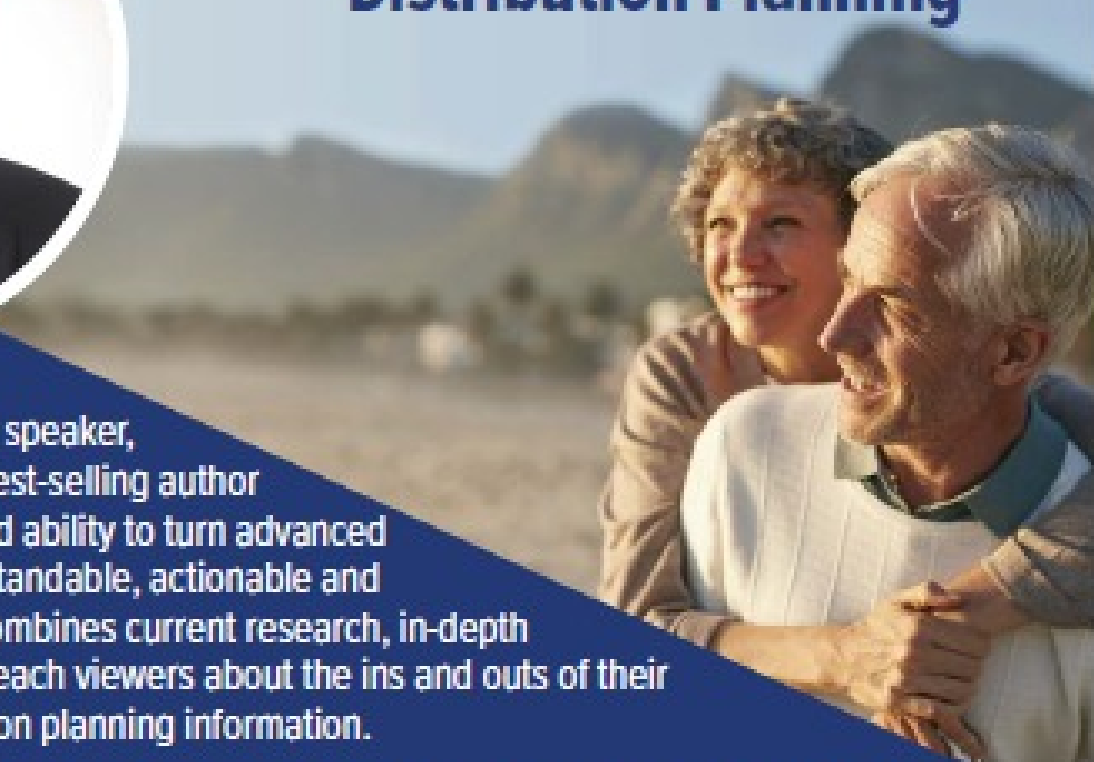
