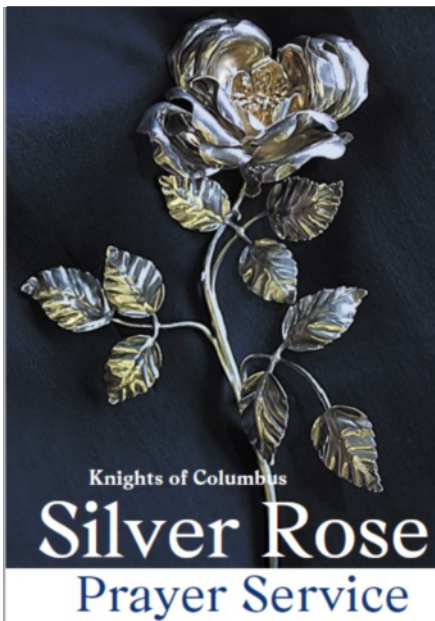

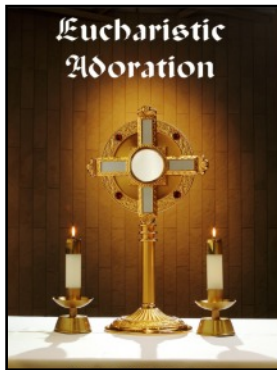

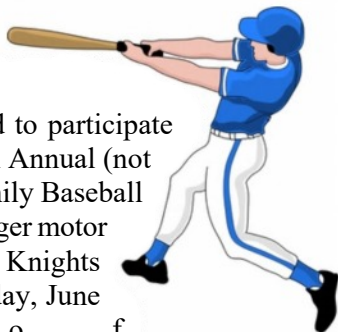

## Silver Rose reception needs!

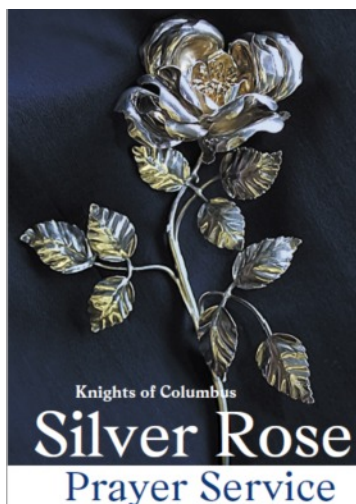
